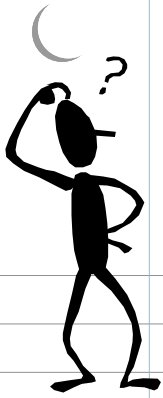

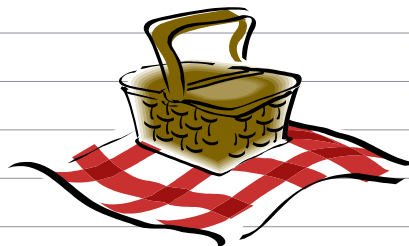
Other stuff to know about...
